

Direct Object pronoun (DOP)

Direct Objects → who or what of the verb.

- ① Find verb (underline)
- ② Who or what? (circle)

I eat pizza every day

Direct Object Pronoun → Replaces Direct Object
(Lazy) (him, her, them, me, it, us)

I eat pizza every day

D.O.P. DOP (it)

Placement

- 2 verbs:

1st verb conjugated, 2nd verb infinitive

Quiero comer pizza

1) Before both verbs

2) After both verbs attached to verb

infinitive

1) Quiero comer

pizza → La Quiero comer.

2) Quiero comer ← one word

Quiero comernla.

- She prepares ice cream.

Ella prepara (helado). DO → Lo

She prepares it.

-(Ella) Lo prepara.

- She wants to prepare the ice cream.

1) Ella quiere prepararlo.

2) Lo quiere preparar
