

Direct Object Pronoun (DOP)

Direct Objects → who or what of the verb.

- ① Find verb (underline)
- ② Who or what? (circle)

I eat (pizza) every day

Direct Object Pronoun → Replaces Direct Object  
(Lazy) (him, her, them, me, it, us)

I eat (pizza) every day

1 conjugated verb  
the DOP is before the  
verb.

La como.  
(I eat it)

\* Left hand facing you

Placement  
- 2 verbs:  $\left\{ \begin{array}{l} 1) \text{ Before both verbs} \\ 2) \text{ After both verbs attached to verb} \end{array} \right.$

1<sup>st</sup> verb conjugated, 2<sup>nd</sup> verb infinitive

Quiero comer pizza

1) Quiero comer

pizza → La Quiero comer.

2) Quiero comer ← one word

Quiero comerla.

- She prepares ice cream.

Ella prepara helado. DO → LO

She prepares it.

-(Ella) LO prepara.

- She wants to prepare the ice cream.

1) Ella quiere prepararlo.

2) Lo quiere preparar
