I give the gift to him.

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Direct Object Pronouns (DOP)	
me	nos
te	vos
lo/la	los/las


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Indirect Objects (IO)


To/for whom of the verb.

To/for what

I give the gift to him.

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Indirect Object Pronouns (IOP)	
me	nos
te	✓
le	les

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D.O.P Replaces the D.O.

I give the gift.

20 day.

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If you have an indirect
object you must write the
IOP.

I give the gift to her

Yo le doy el Regalo
(a ella).

~~Doy el Regalo a ella.~~

You can have an IOP if no IO

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DOP

I tell the truth
La digo.

IOP

I tell the truth to her.

Le digo la verdad
(a ella).

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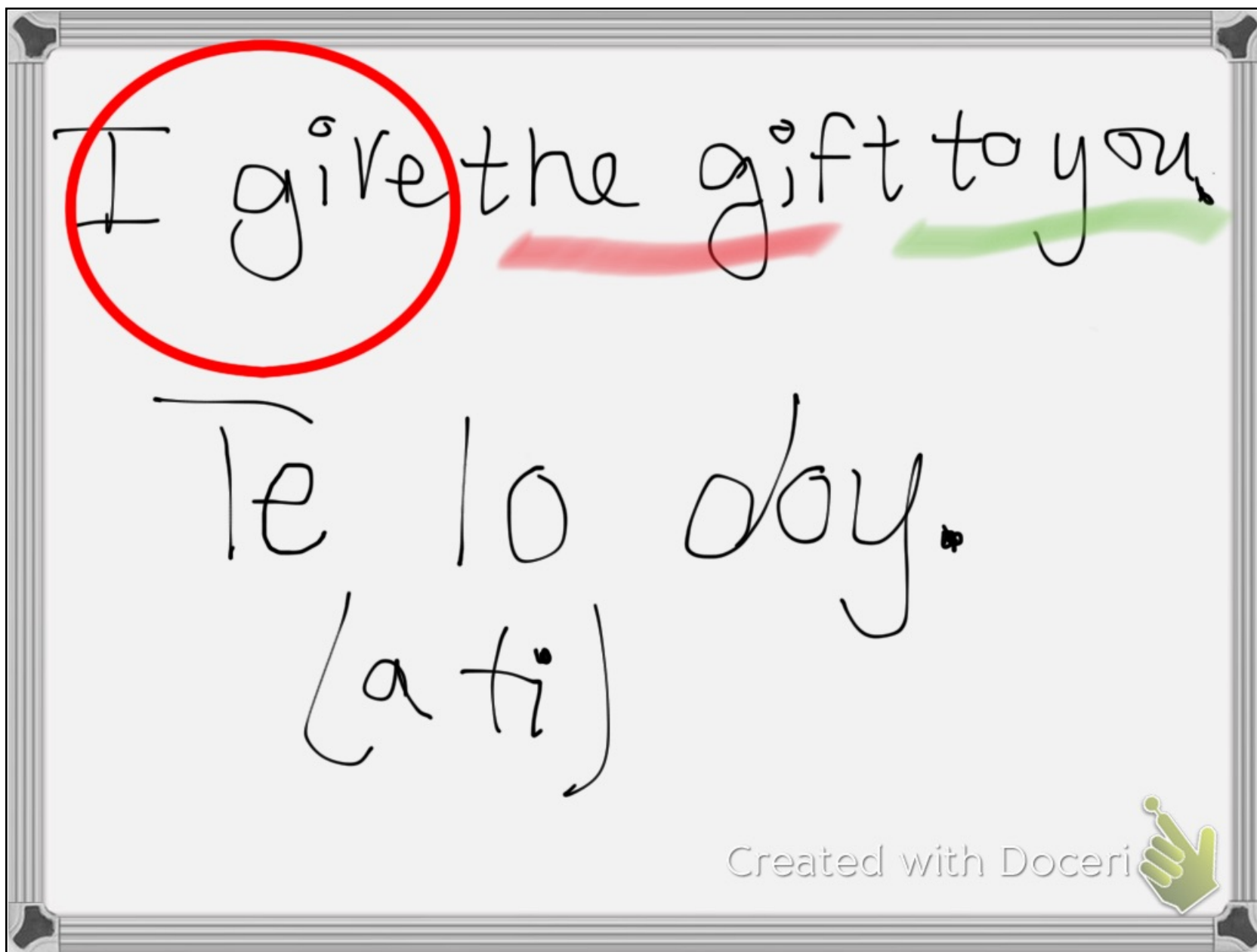


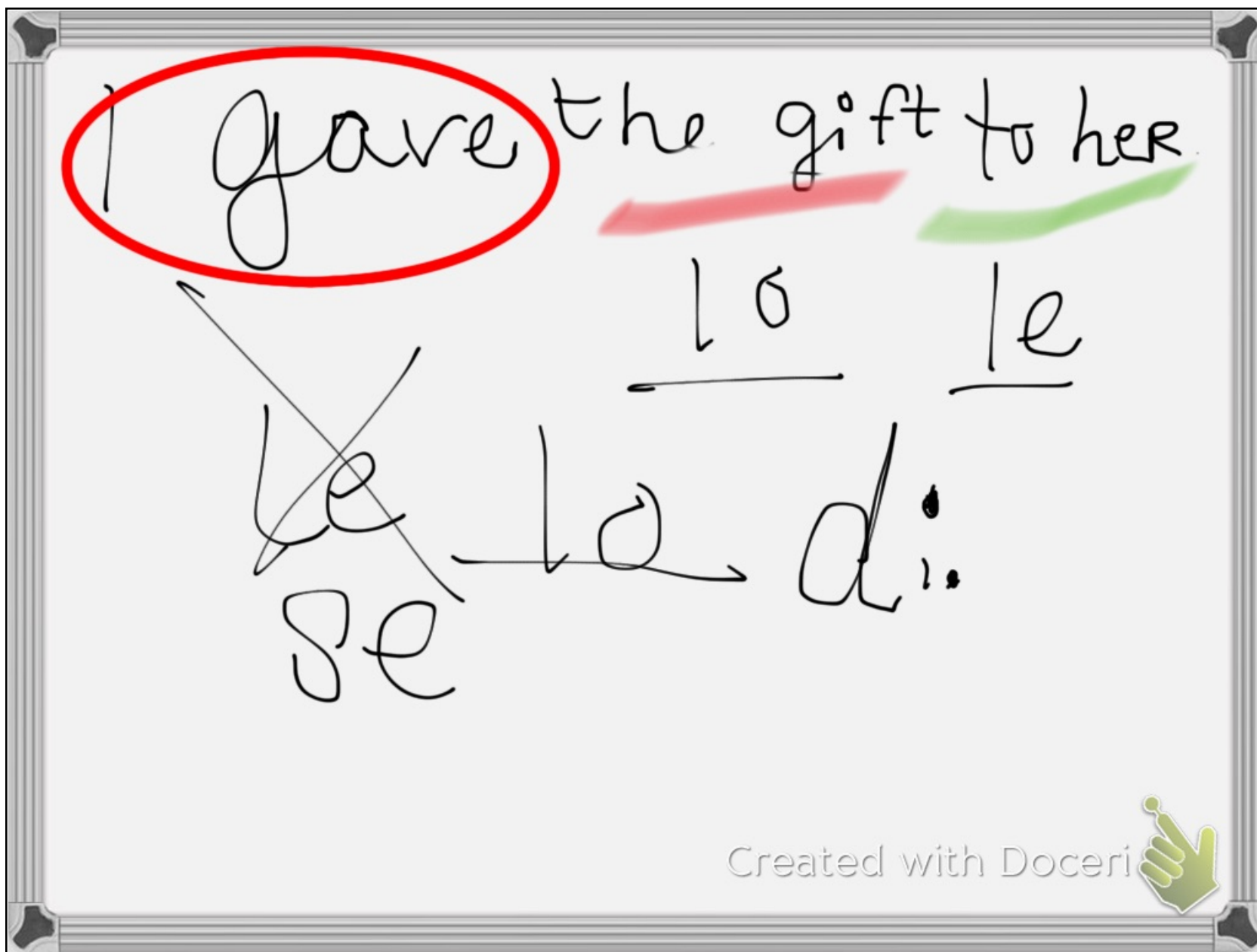
DOUBLE OBJECT PRONOUNS

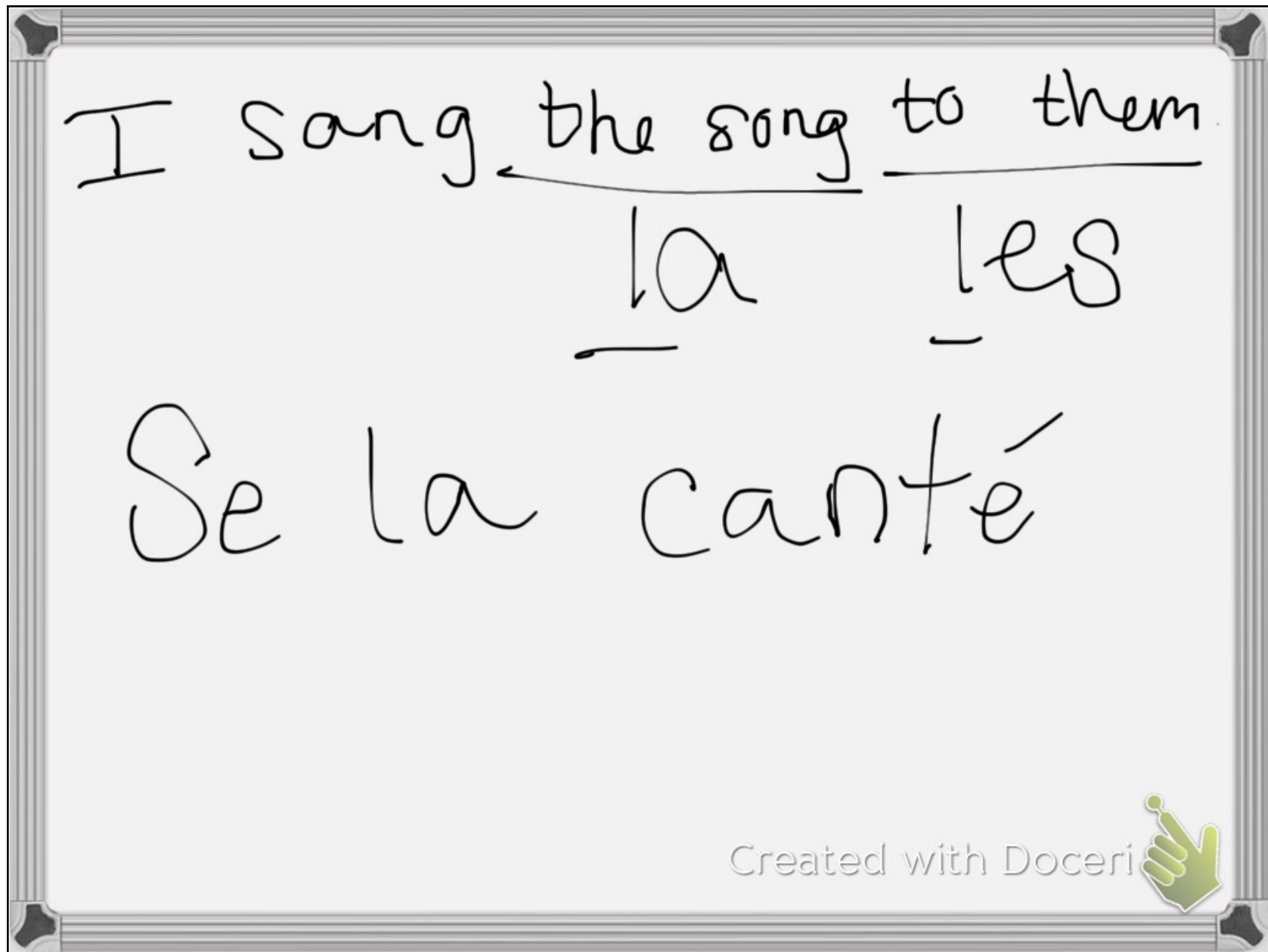
↳ Indirect before direct,
Reflexive first of all"

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Where do pronouns go?



- 1 conjugated verb = in front
- 3 times when pronoun goes behind

★ ACCENT MARKS!

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1) Infinitive
"I want to make it"


Cono


★ Accent if 2 pronouns added

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2) Gerund (-ing)
 "I am making it."

Lo estoy haciendo.

Estoy haciéndolo.

★ Always add

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3) Affirmative command
Make it! (vd.)
haga lo

- Pronoun MUST follow command
- If command is 1 syllable
and only 1 pronoun added,
no accent

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I want to give him the gift.

1) Se lo quiero dar.

2) Quiero dárselo.


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I am giving him the gift

1) Estoy dándoselo

2. Se lo estoy dando

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(Tú) Give him the gift!

1) Dásele

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We are Reading the book
to you. (informal)

1 Estamos leyéndote lo

2 Te lo estamos
leyendo

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
